Discounts on parts and service at participating dealers (Bob Stall and others).

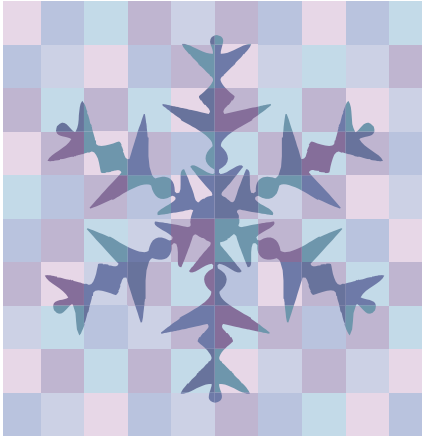
A club T-shirt.
